


Human Resource Development in Pediatric Surgery and Its related Field in Mongolia

- National Center for Maternal and Child Health (NCMCH) is the tertiary institution for maternal and pediatric medicine in Mongolia and the country wants to implement Pediatric Liver Transplantation at the institution.
- National Center for Child Health and Development (NCCHD) is the institution with rich experience in liver transplantation in Japan. Collaboration between these two institution, including joint surgery in Mongolia and training in Japan, will facilitate to implement pediatric liver transplantation program in Mongolia.
- Establishment of the liver transplantation program in Mongolia, which will improve quality of life of the patients with liver diseases
