

Project to improve the quality of perinatal care and develop human resources to reduce maternal mortality and stillbirth rates in Zambia

- The Perinatal and Maternal Center of Ehime University Hospital and the University of Zambia will jointly conduct human resource development and environmental improvement activities to improve perinatal care in Zambia.
- Ehime University will send doctors and midwives to train doctors and midwives in the use of ultrasound equipment, and invite doctors and midwives from the local area to Ehime University for training.
- Establish an online system to allow young doctors who are sent to remote clinics to perform ultrasound examinations to receive instruction at a higher-level facility.
- Teaching management methods for early diagnosis and appropriate treatment of hypertensive disorders of pregnancy based on the guidelines of the Japanese Society of hypertensive disorders of pregnancy.
