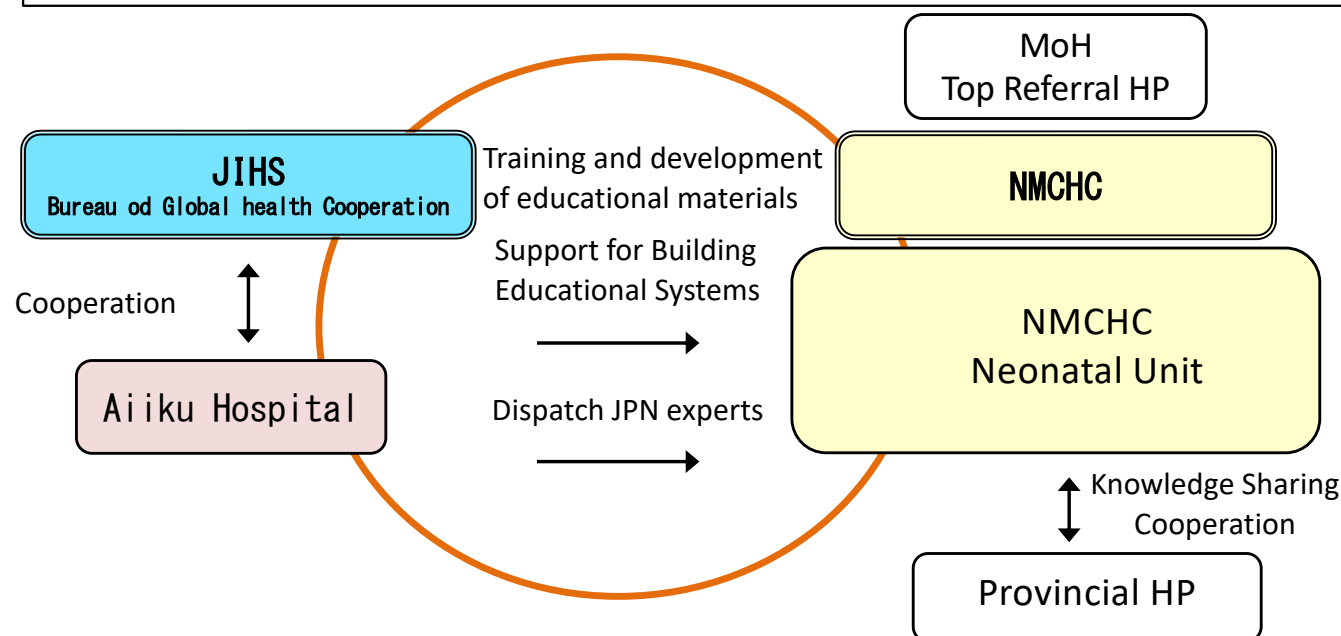


Human Resource Development Project for Neonatal Care Services in Cambodia (The third year of a three-year plan)

1. Capacity building of healthcare personnel to provide advanced medical care such as ventilators in neonatal intensive care units and high-quality nursing care
2. In this project, JIHS in cooperation with and Aiiiku Hospital, will transfer Japan's advanced neonatal intensive care techniques to the NMCHC neonatal unit personnel, improving doctors' diagnostic and treatment capabilities underlying neonatal ventilator management, and enhancing the quality of nursing care provided by nurses.
3. Develop educational materials for neonatal ventilation management and nursing care for high-risk newborns to introduce advanced medical care such as ventilators. Nurse instructors and a head nurse use these educational materials to conduct training for newly graduated nurses. The educational materials and teaching experience at NMCHC are introduced to personnel related to neonatal care at provincial hospitals.
