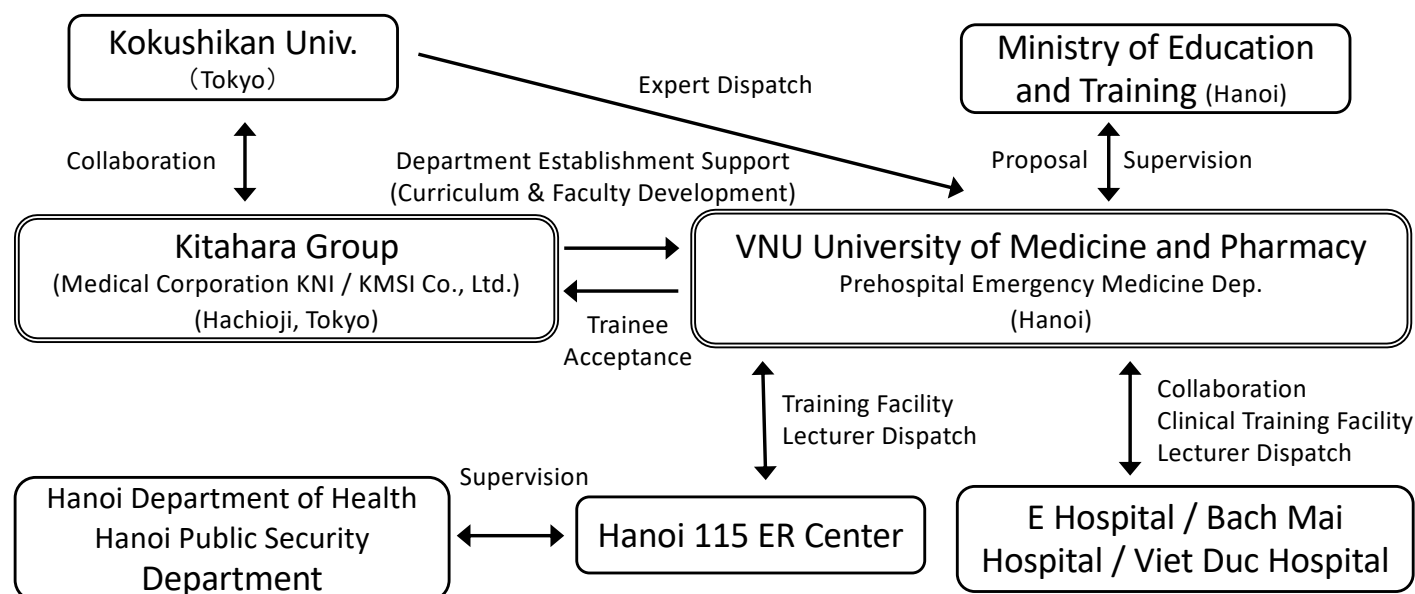


Support Project for Establishing a Paramedic Education Program in Vietnam Year 3 of the 3-Year Plan

1. This project supports the establishment of a paramedic education program at Vietnam National University of Medicine and Pharmacy by introducing Japan's education and training system.
2. Kitahara Group and Kokushikan University collaborate to provide instructor training, emergency care training, curriculum support, and educational material development based on Japan's paramedic system.
3. The project aims to prepare the curriculum and educational materials required for future program approval and contribute to the development of Vietnam's prehospital emergency workforce.
