

Project for Strengthening Team Approach and Regional Cooperation for Stroke patients at Stroke Centers in Northern Vietnam

Overview of the Project

1. Project Objective:

Through collaboration with Bach Mai Hospital (BMH), the project aims to contribute to improving the quality of stroke care, rehabilitation, nutrition, and nursing, as well as strengthening team-based medical systems at the Second Bach Mai Hospital and regional hospitals in Northern Vietnam.

2. Project Outline:

Under the cooperation agreement between JIHS and BMH, the project will promote the clinical implementation of technologies previously supported, and disseminate them—under BMH's leadership—to the Second Bach Mai Hospital and surrounding regional hospitals. The project will also work to enhance team-based medical care.

3. Expected Outcomes and Final Goals:

Clinical practices, regulations, and guidelines related to stroke care in Vietnam will be developed and approved by the Ministry of Health, and included in the national health insurance system. Stroke care practices will be disseminated to the Second Bach Mai Hospital and regional hospitals in Northern Vietnam. Medical products related to stroke care will also be widely implemented.
