

Project to Improve Delivery Care Skills of Midwives in Mongolia;
Establishing the foundation for national dissemination and Providing technical trainings aligned with the expanded roles of midwives.

Objective: To establish a nationwide system to implement delivery care skills training for midwives, and strengthening the capacity of Mongolian instructors in line with the expanded role under the updated Mongolian standards.

Overview: The Tokyo Midwives Foundation, in collaboration with the Mongolian Midwives Association, will select regional training hubs and strengthen their training capacities. In addition, Training of Trainers (TOT) will be conducted for Mongolian instructors on newly required skills under the expanded scope of midwives’ practice, thereby preparing for nationwide training delivery in the future.

Outcome:

- Midwives in all 21 provinces gain access to the training via the nationwide dissemination system on delivery care skills training.
- Mongolian midwives instructors will be able to train other midwives on newly required skills under the expanded scope of practice.
