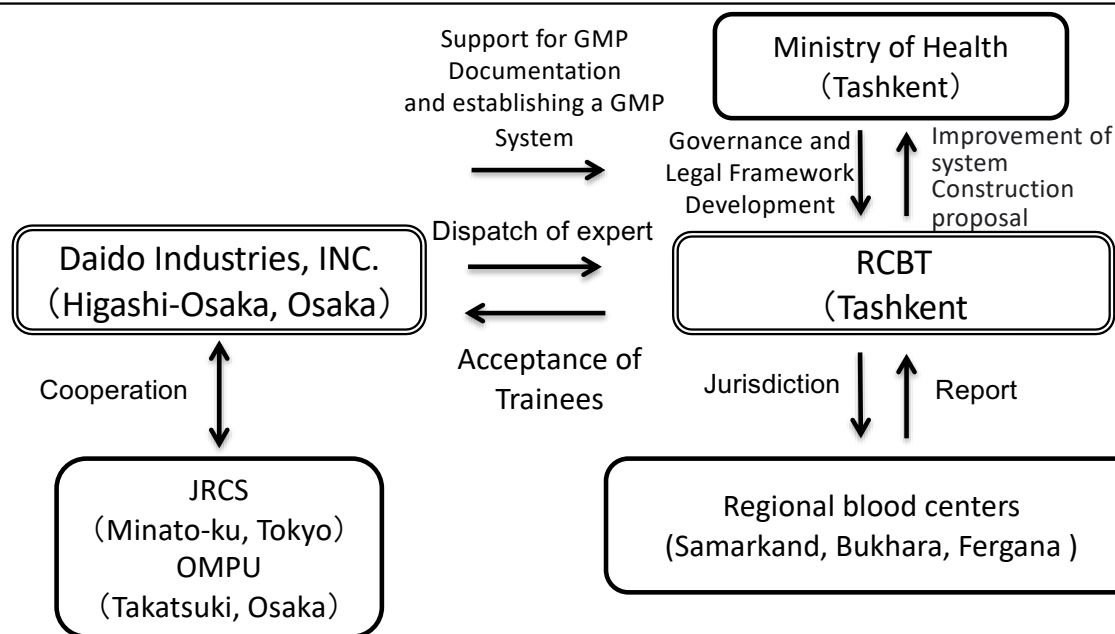


Project for Strengthening the Blood Storage and Transportation System in Uzbekistan First year of a 3-year plan

1. In 2023, Uzbekistan recorded 280,654 blood donors, representing 0.8% of the population—below the WHO recommended level of 1%. This project aims to strengthen the blood storage and transportation system and contribute to achieving Universal Health Coverage (UHC) in Blood transfusion medicine.
2. The Republican Center for Blood Transfusion (RCBT), Ministry of Health of Uzbekistan aims to establish an internationally compliant GMP system. To achieve this, a structured documentation system (GMP guidelines, standards, and procedures) must be developed. Daido Industries, INC. , the Japanese Red Cross Society(JRCS), and Osaka Medical and Pharmaceutical University(OMPU) will support the preparation of GMP-related documentation through expert dispatch and training programs in Japan
3. Through this three-year project, GMP management documentation established at the RCBT will be disseminated to regional blood centers, contributing to the development and expansion of Uzbekistan’s blood services. At the same time, the project will help establish areas where Japanese-style medical technologies can take the initiative.
